

Advance Programme on best practices on HIV prevention for officers who are implementing HIV prevention

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This advance training is offered for public health practitioners who have at least one year of experience working for HIV prevention. This training includes schedule such as HIV prevention and activities associated with it. It will have the refreshers course of basic training of the program. It has the components of program management, strategies for leadership strengthening, good governance, surveillance system, health promotion against stigma and discrimination, program monitoring and evaluation, HIV and migrants and work of Civil Society Organisation and Key Populations. The participants are expected to be expert in the HIV program in their home country and should be aware of their policy and program about HIV situation. The participants will have fieldworks such as continuum of care for people living with HIV and access to Anti-retroviral therapy, PLHIV, approaches of working with Key populations, observe the work of Red Cross Society for people affected with HIV. The participants will also have the opportunity to observe the program implemented by CSO for the migrants and drug injectors.
